

## **MINUTES of a meeting of Landulph Parish Council held on Monday June 15<sup>th</sup> 2009 at 7.30pm in the Landulph Memorial Hall Annexe, Landulph.**

Councillor Creagh-Osborne was of the opinion that the contractor had responded and undertaken the work in the month between meetings and this was a satisfactory response.
