

MINUTES of a meeting of Landulph Parish Council held on Monday 19th April 2010 at 7.30pm in the Landulph Memorial Hall Annexe, Landulph.

A SHORT PUBLIC FORUM PRECEDED THE MAIN MEETING.

1 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were submitted on behalf of the Community Network Manager, Simon Swale.

2 CORNWALL COUNCIL REPORT

Councillor Mrs O.Eggleston reminded members that the next cluster meeting will be held at Ashtorre Rock, Waterside, Saltash. Councillor Mrs Eggleston confirmed that topics to be discussed included anti-social behaviour and speeding and that a senior Cornwall Council officer would be in attendance. It was further confirmed that a 2 day exhibition of the Royal Albert Bridge would be held at the same venue on Sunday 25th and Monday 26th April.

1 MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes of the meeting held on Monday 15th March 2010 were taken as read, confirmed and signed by the Chairman.

2 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

a) Waste:-

Pursuant to minute 90(a), receipt was reported of an email from Cornwall Council confirming that the consultation had not been undertaken and that this council would be informed when this was undertaken. The email was noted.
